An infographic is a visual image like a chart or diagram used to represent data or information.

For your infographic:

- Pick a key theme or concept from the guest speaker presentation that you like and interests you.
- Do some additional research to verify and expand on your concept. Be sure to list your sources that you use in a separate Word document.
- Piktochart and Venngage have free online versions with lots of usability, but you have to pay if you want to download your finished product. Piktochart has been reported as more user friendly for students. Word works just fine as well.

A good Infographic will:

- Have a title that describes what your infographic is about.
- Share information; show how something works, or a statistical representation of an idea.
- Pertain to the Share the Road presentation.
- Use a variety of different tools photos, backgrounds, drawings, or illustrations, that help to promote the main idea.
- Include statistics.
- Promote an understanding of your key idea, for every photo or image have a concise statement to help your audience understand it.
- Does not plagiarize.
